Offer your help if you want to help, ask for help if you need help, share your great ideas

This coronacrisis leads to a situation which is drastic to everyone.

Public gatherings are banned, schools, universities, pubs, etcetera, are closed, and people who have a cold, are coughing or sneezing or have a fever are urgently advised to stay at home. The children have to stay at home (and thus babysits are needed), also vulnerable people are advised to stay at home. Furthermore, since this week, nursing homes do not allow any visitors anymore.

Our usual social life has to be organized in a different way, and we all still have to get used to that.

Most of us are lucky to be able to use the internet, whats-app, email, and all other virtual devices to keep in contact with each other and to stay informed about the most recent developments.

There are many, especially older more vulnerable people, however, who don't have access to the internet and who are in great risk of (social) isolation. They cannot get the information they usually get when they come to church. There are people who are not able to do their shoppings anymore, or need some other practical help. There are people who are afraid, are in need for a listening ear, or are in need for a spiritual conversation. Perhaps you know someone who is in need for help.

On the other hand, this crisis also leads to togetherness and to exploring ones creativity in order offer help. New ideas pop up regularly. People want to help, and people do have ideas.

Our parish wants to bring those who can help and those in need in contact with each other.

Dutch newsletter

Alternatives for Holy Mass, Palm Sunday, Good Week, Easter

As announced in the previous newsflash, the Dutch bishops have announced that the public liturgical celebrations on Palmsunday, all other days of the Good Week and Easter are cancelled. All previously taken measures are extended until April 13.... They have decided this with pain in their hearts.

Of course we think about ways to offer alternatives, which we are well aware that cannot replace the Holy Eucharist.

Some examples:

Church

In Wageningen, the chapel of the church will stay open every day from 8:30 - 20:00 for prayer and for lighting a candle.

Holy Mass

If possible, the Dutch Holy Mass and the International Mass will be recorded weekly.

We used to have Adoration frequently in Wageningen, organized by the Eucharistic Adoration Committee of our parish.

Also this week there will be opportunity for silent Adoration in our church: Tuesday March 24 from 18:00 - 20:00, Thursday March 26 from 15:30 - 18.30, and Saturday March 28 from 19:00 - 21:00.

Conform the recommendation of the Dutch bishops, there will be opportunity to offer durable food for the food bank when the Holy Sacrament is exposed for Worship.

The committee probably will arrange other moments for Adoration.

Advices RIVM (National Institute for public health and environment)

The RIVM (the National Institute for public health and the environment), advised following measures to avoid spreading the coronavirus:

- take into account a physical distance between each other of at least 1.5 meter
- wash your hands regularly
- if you have to sneeze or cough do it in the inside of your elbow
- use paper handkerchiefs
- if you have a cold, if you have to cough, if you have a sore throat or fever; stay at home, avoid contact. Do not call your doctor until complaints get worse.

St. Thomas Aquinas defined a Spiritual Communion as "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament and in lovingly embracing Him as if we had actually received Him."
